

NO THRUSH® Rain Rot Photo journal – Day 1 through day 20

OZ - Day 1: Oz is a retired pasture horse. This rain rot was not actually created by “rain.” It was created by sweat drying on the coat during the hot summer days, and dew accumulating overnight. This established a bacterial breeding ground which attacked the skin.

PROTOCOL: Oz’s back was dusted once per day for 4 days, and then once every 2-3 days thereafter. **Note that at Day 20** all raw areas have filled in with healthy coat. We will continue to dust 1-2 times per week until 100% of the coat is thick and lush.

LEFT RUMP: Day 1 below – Day 20 on the Right)



RIGHT RUMP – Before and After – (BELOW)



Day 1: The photo to the left is immediately after dusting with NO THRUSH®. Note the balding areas and the tufts of coat coming out.

We simply puffed NT on and rubbed it into the affected area.

Day 20: The photo on the right: Full coat regrowth.
